Board of Education Member
Vacancy and Application Process**

The Board of Education is seeking interested applicants to fill the vacancy of a Board member. This person would serve on the board until the next school board election in April 2019. Statutory requirements to serve on the Board of Education are (1) must be at least 18 years of age at the time of the appointment, (2) must be a resident of the state and district for at least one school year preceding appointment, (3) must be a registered voter, (4) not a school trustee or school treasurer and, (4) shall not be a child sex offender as defined in Section 11-9.3 of the Criminal Code.

The letter of interest and resume should include the following information as may apply to the applicant: (1) Community service and affiliations, (2) Occupations and Education, (3) Family school connections (e.g. Child's schools of attendance), (4) reason for your interest in board service in Palos 118, and (5) such additional information that would assist the board in making this appointment.

The Board of Education shall conduct such interviews to fill the vacancy as it determines appropriate in accordance with the School Code. Application materials sent to the board will not be returned.
