## 12 Things Principals and Teachers Can Do to Help Homeless & Highly Mobile Students:

- 1. Welcome students!
- 2. Ensure that staff who work directly with a student staying in a shelter are aware of the situation and respect the student's privacy about this living situation.
- 3. Make sure parents feel comfortable and let them know they are welcome in your school.
- 4. Select a student to be the buddy on first day of class.
- 5. Offer tools to complete any required task. Supplies may not be available for the child.
- 6. Provide a clipboard when possible as a portable desk.
- 7. Provide a space for the student to store his/her belongings.
- 8. Have necessary toiletry items on hand to ensure proper hygiene at school.
- 9. Keep a supply of nutritional snacks in your room.
- 10. Refer to on-site tutoring programs for educational assistance.
- 11. Help students make plans for transportation for after school activities or other special events.
- 12. Provide inservice for all school staff to ensure they are sensitive to the needs of homeless students.
