Question/Comment:

Is there going to be summer school offered for kids that are in need?

Answer:

District 118 is offering summer school math intervention to students who qualify. The program runs from July 12th through August 20th using a blended in-person and virtual model.

Additionally, the District has purchased Dreambox Learning (grades 1-3) and MAP Accelerator (grades 4-8) accounts for all students entering grades 2-8 next school year so students can learn math over the summer. Both programs are researched-based and follow specific learning pathways to meet students at their current instructional levels to help them grow. Student log-in information will be sent home in report card envelopes and be posted on the Skyward Parent Portal. Schools will be sending out information throughout the summer incentivizing student participation and support is available for families who need technical assistance or have any questions.
