Dear Families,

Thank you for your continued partnership as we navigate the many challenges schools face as a result of COVID-19. The partnership between school and community remains essential for student success.

At last night's special meeting, the Board of Education approved the school district's plan and timeline for reopening schools to in-person instruction. You should have received an email from Dr. Scarsella earlier today that provided a brief synopsis of the plan. More detailed information will be available on the district's website tomorrow. Additionally, the school district is hosting informational meetings tomorrow and Thursday. The school district's timeline and meeting details are found below.

An important component of the reopening plan is parental choice. Families will have the ability to reelect either in-person or remote learning. All families are required to complete the <u>Instructional</u> <u>Program Election Form</u> to select an option for their child by no later than Monday, September 28th at 10:00 a.m. A separate form needs to be filled out for each child. We ask that you please wait to make your election until after reviewing the detailed plan information that will be posted on the district website tomorrow or attending one of the informational evenings. Parents will have the option to attend in-person or virtually.

Please know that regardless of selecting modified in-person or remote learning, there is a possibility that your child's teacher(s) may change. The data we receive back from the completed election forms will determine to what extent these changes occur. Please do not base your decision on whether or not your child will have the same teacher. Instead, base your decision on whether or not you are comfortable with sending your child back to school.

We understand that transitioning can be stressful for both students and parents. Please know that our intention is to provide the very best for our students, whether in-person or remotely.
