Dear Palos 118 Families,

Thank you for your partnership this week as we reopened schools after our winter recess. If you have been following the news, you may have heard of a few school districts that have canceled in-person learning due to staffing shortages. Palos 118 did have adequate staffing to reopen on Wednesday, but staffing will be our biggest challenge in the weeks to come. Guidance from ISBE on school closures due to staffing shortages has been unclear and school districts continue to seek clarification on whether elearning days can be used in lieu of in-person learning when schools cannot operate safely due to unfilled staff positions.

I received a few emails this week asking me to declare an adaptive pause and transition to remote-only learning due to increasing positivity rates. Local school superintendents no longer have the authority to declare an adaptive pause. This power was stripped from us at the beginning of this school year. Only IDPH (Illinois Department of Health) and CCDPH (Cook County Department of Public Health) can approve an adaptive pause if they deem schools to be unsafe.

New Reporting Procedures for Positive COVID-19 Cases

We anticipate an increased level of parents reporting positive students in the next few weeks. To expedite the reporting process, we are asking parents to self-report positive cases of students and household members using this <u>Palos 118 – Student COVID Self Reporting Form.</u>

Updated CDC Guidance for K-12

Yesterday, CDC updated its guidance for K-12 schools by reducing the recommended time for isolation and quarantine periods. We anticipate IDPH will adopt CDC's updated guidance soon and are prepared to implement immediately.

Reducing the Potential for Transmission in School

The most effective strategy for reducing the risk of transmission and outbreaks in our schools is limiting the potential for the virus to enter our schools. To do that, we need your help by observing the following:

- Keep symptomatic children at home until symptoms resolve.
- Keep children who test positive at home and contact the school nurse for return to school dates.
- Report any COVID positive household member to the school nurse prior to sending children to school.
- Consider getting children vaccinated or speaking with your family physician if you have concerns regarding vaccinations.
- Consider participating in the school district's onsite COVID-19 testing screening programs. You
